

Downloading Free Apps to Tablets

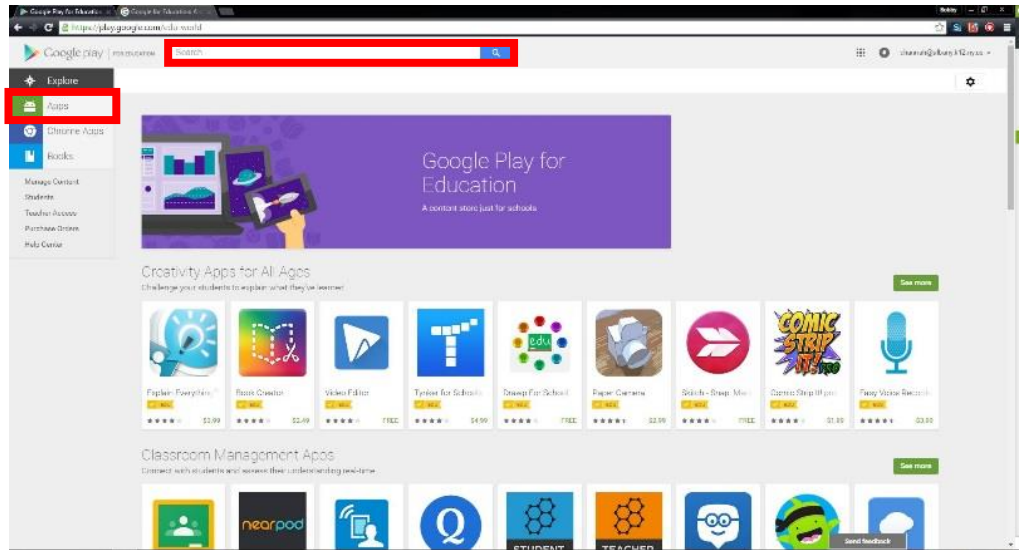
This can be accomplished on a computer or the tablet itself. Tablets must be able to receive apps from the Google Play for Education Store in order for this process to work.

1. Sign in to:
play.google.com/edu
with your full district
email address and
district password.

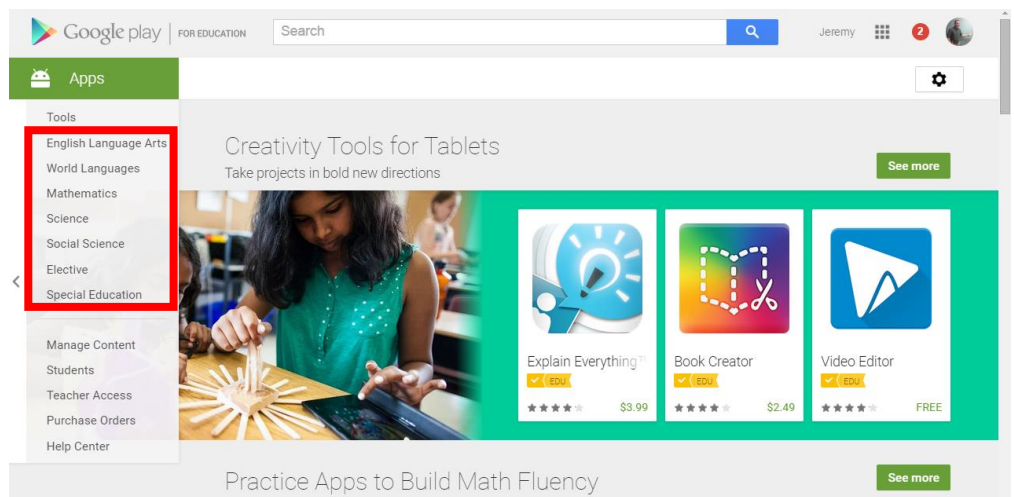
You can locate apps by
clicking on the green
button next to “Apps”

Or

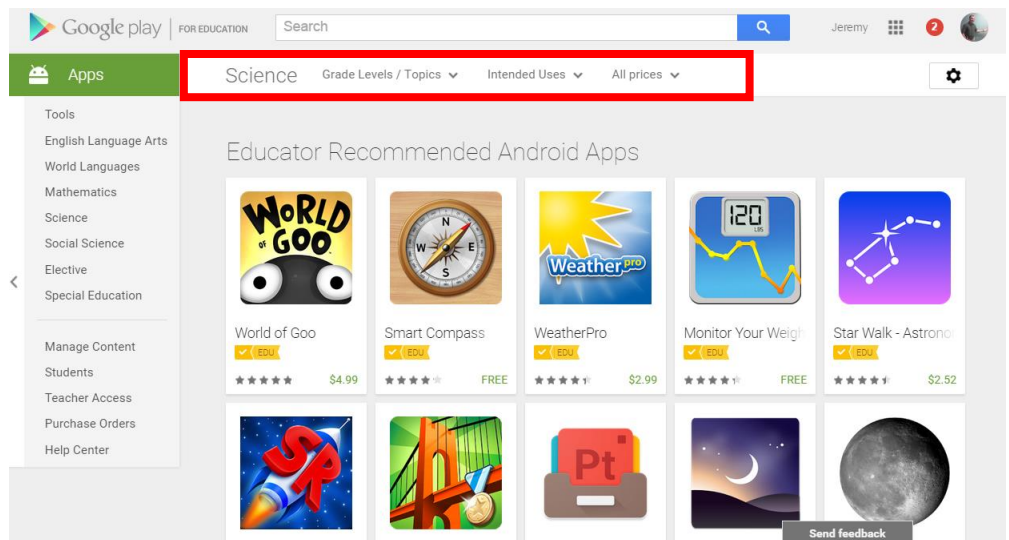
by using the search bar.



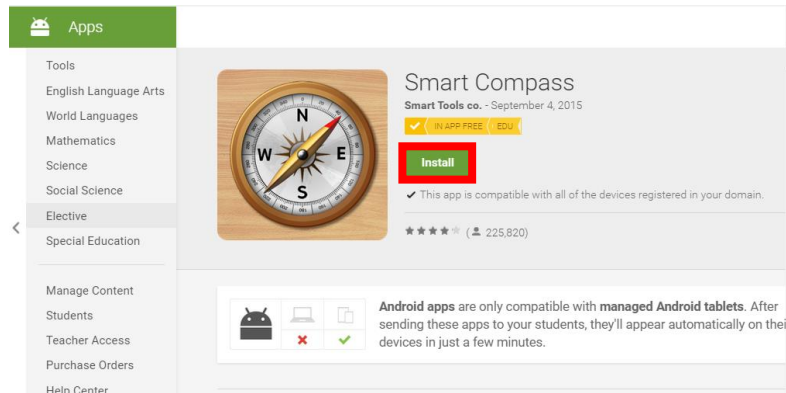
2. If you clicked on the
“Apps” button, the next
screen will allow you to
filter the apps by
content area.



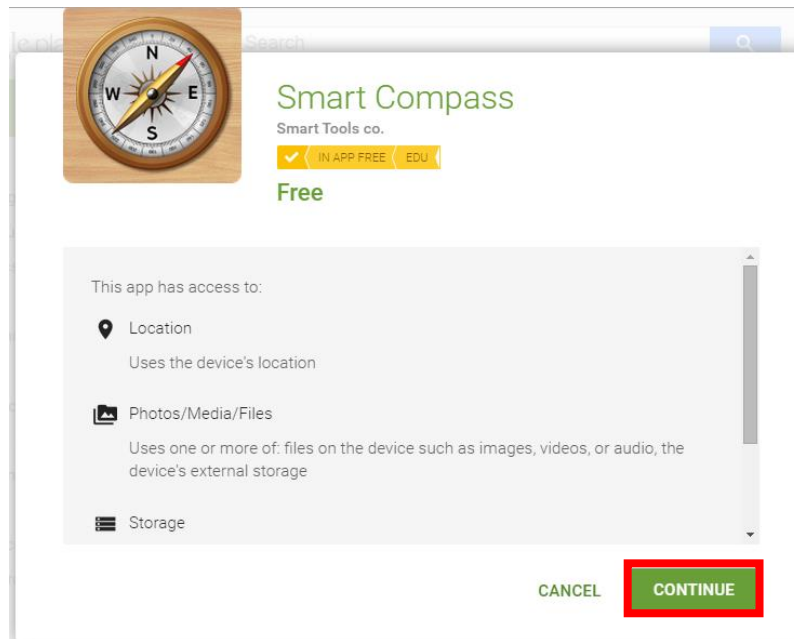
3. Once you’ve selected a
content area, you can
filter the results even
further by the options in
the white bar beneath
the search bar.



4. Once you've selected an app, it will prompt you to click "Install".

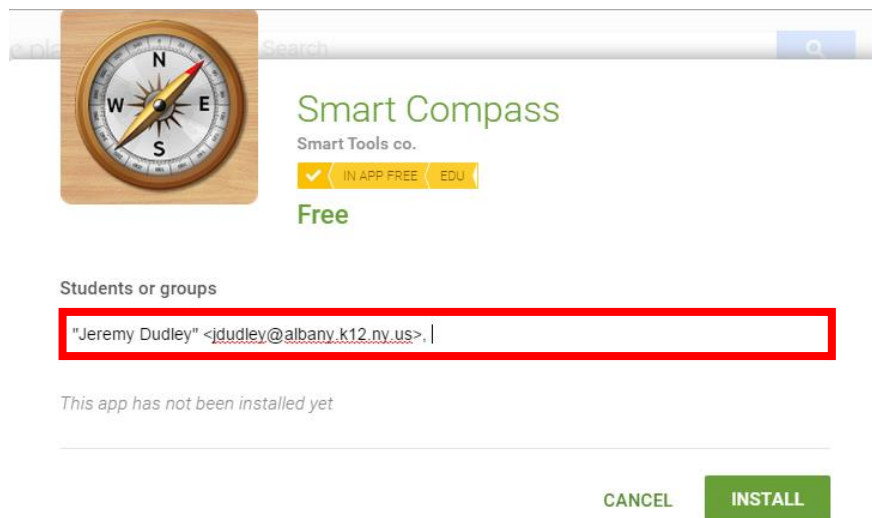


5. It will then tell you the permissions required to install and run the app. Choose "Continue".



6. Next, it will prompt you to assign the app. Type in the email address of the account you want the app associated with.

It's important to understand that apps are associated with accounts. This means that the apps appearing on a tablet will change based on the user.



- Once you've added the accounts and clicked "Install" you should see a screen that verifies the app has been successfully pushed out.

Many apps appear within minutes, but it could take up to 24 hours for an app to appear.
